



#### **3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members**




All together **50** Members from 14 countries, including

#### 4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)






#### 6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2017


#### 7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2017



Corresponding authors of 129 articles published in 2017 come from **26 countries and regions** with 20% of them from USA.




#### 8. Citations of GS (results by year)

#### 9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2017




Retrieval of GS in PubMed increased rapidly with a top of **19077 times** in Nov. 2017.
