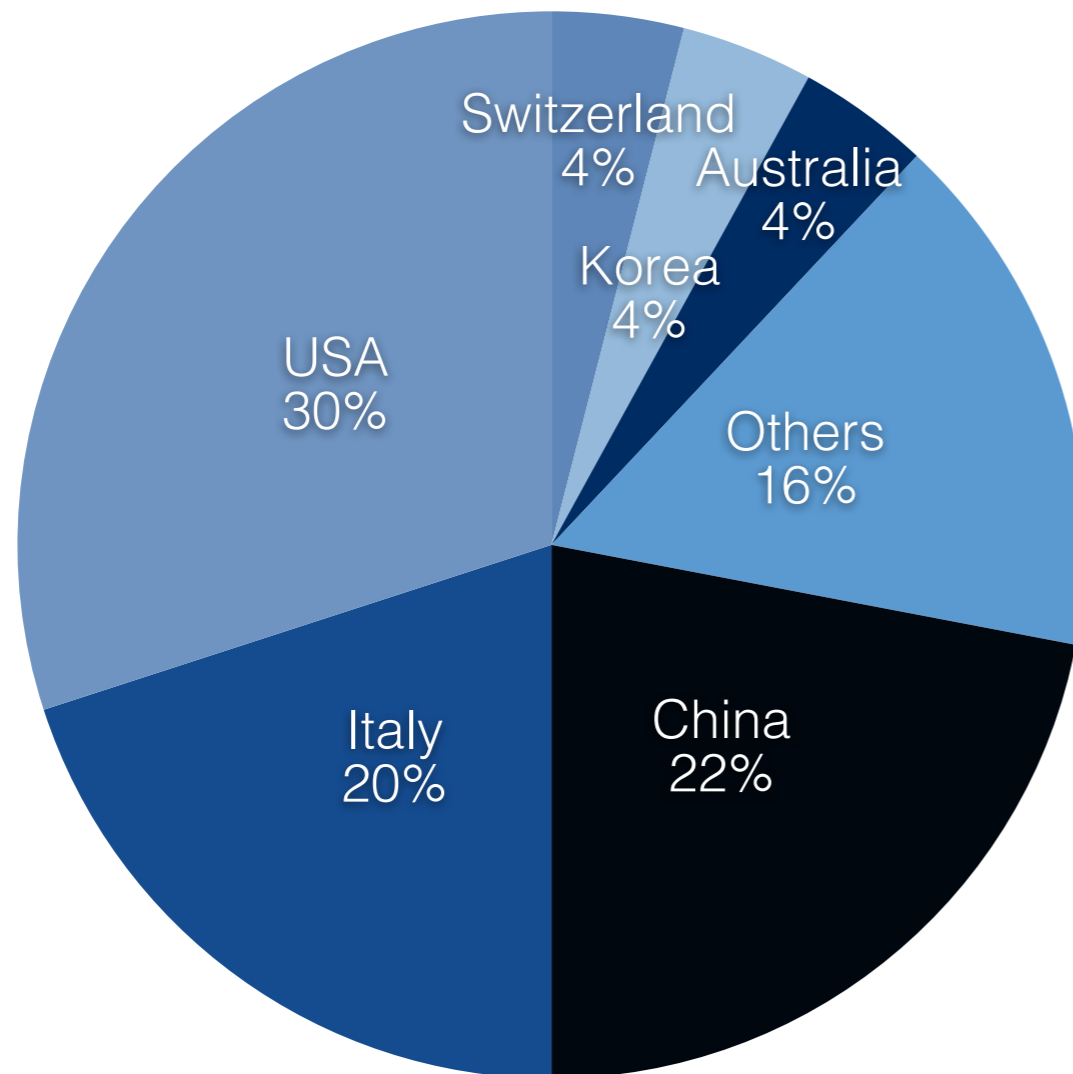

## 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

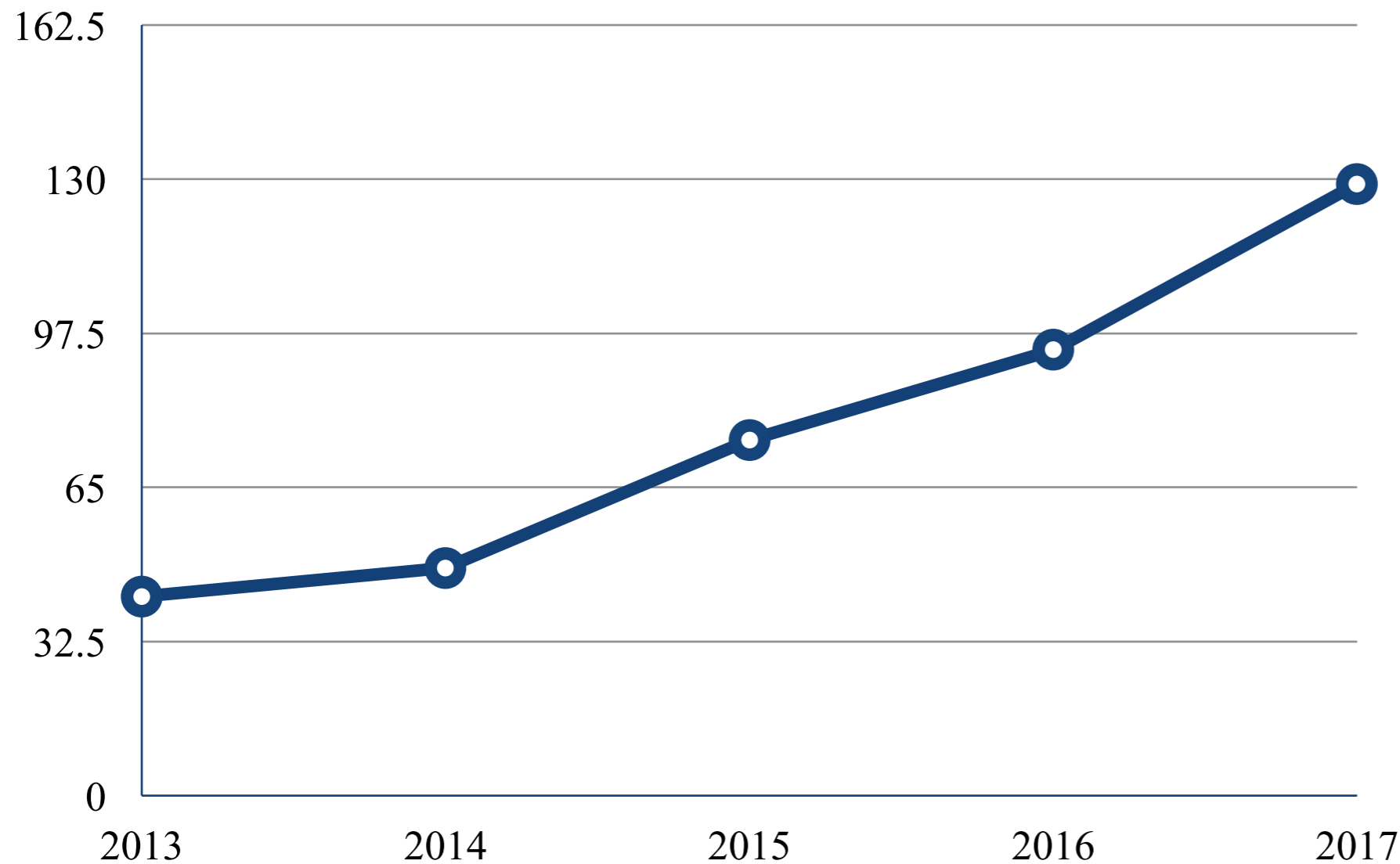

**129** articles published in 2017.

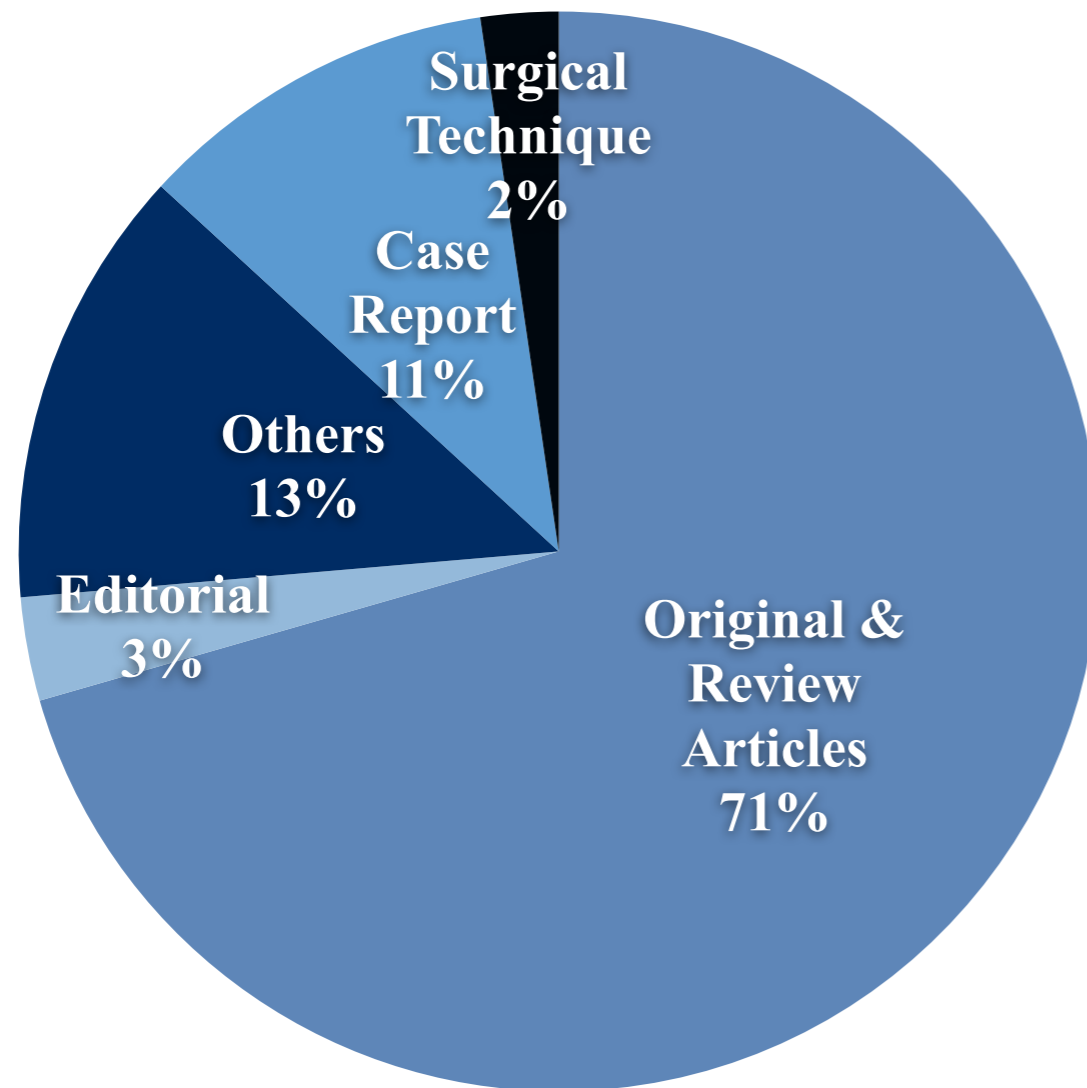

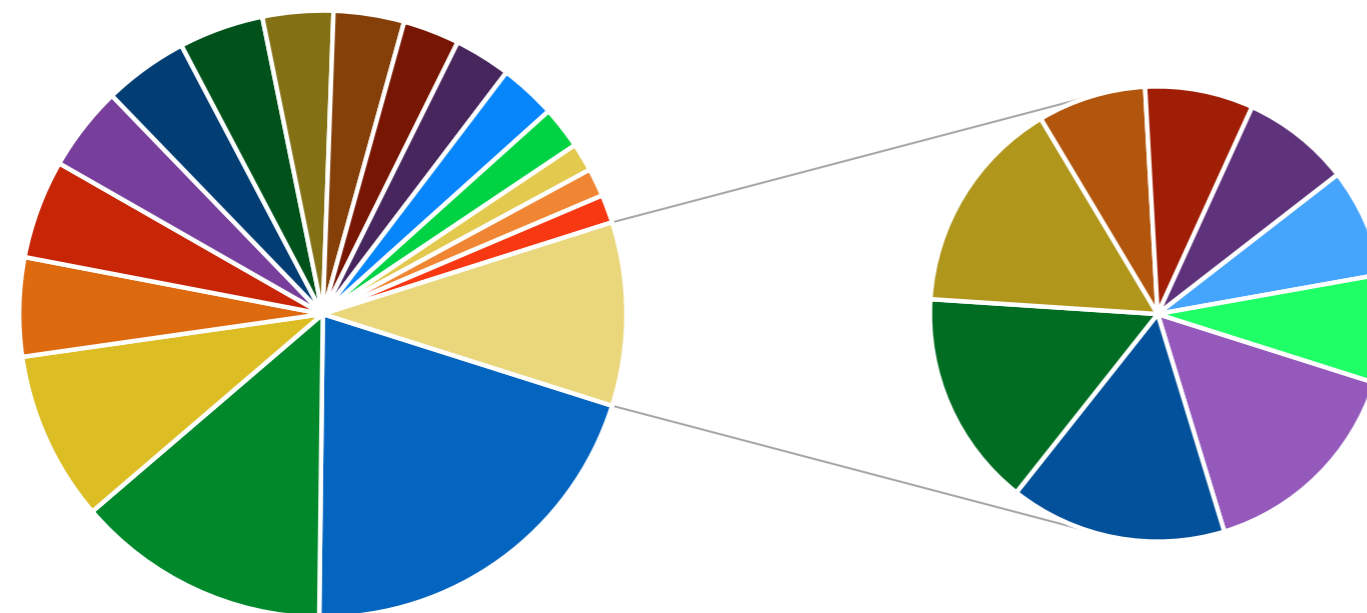
## 6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2017

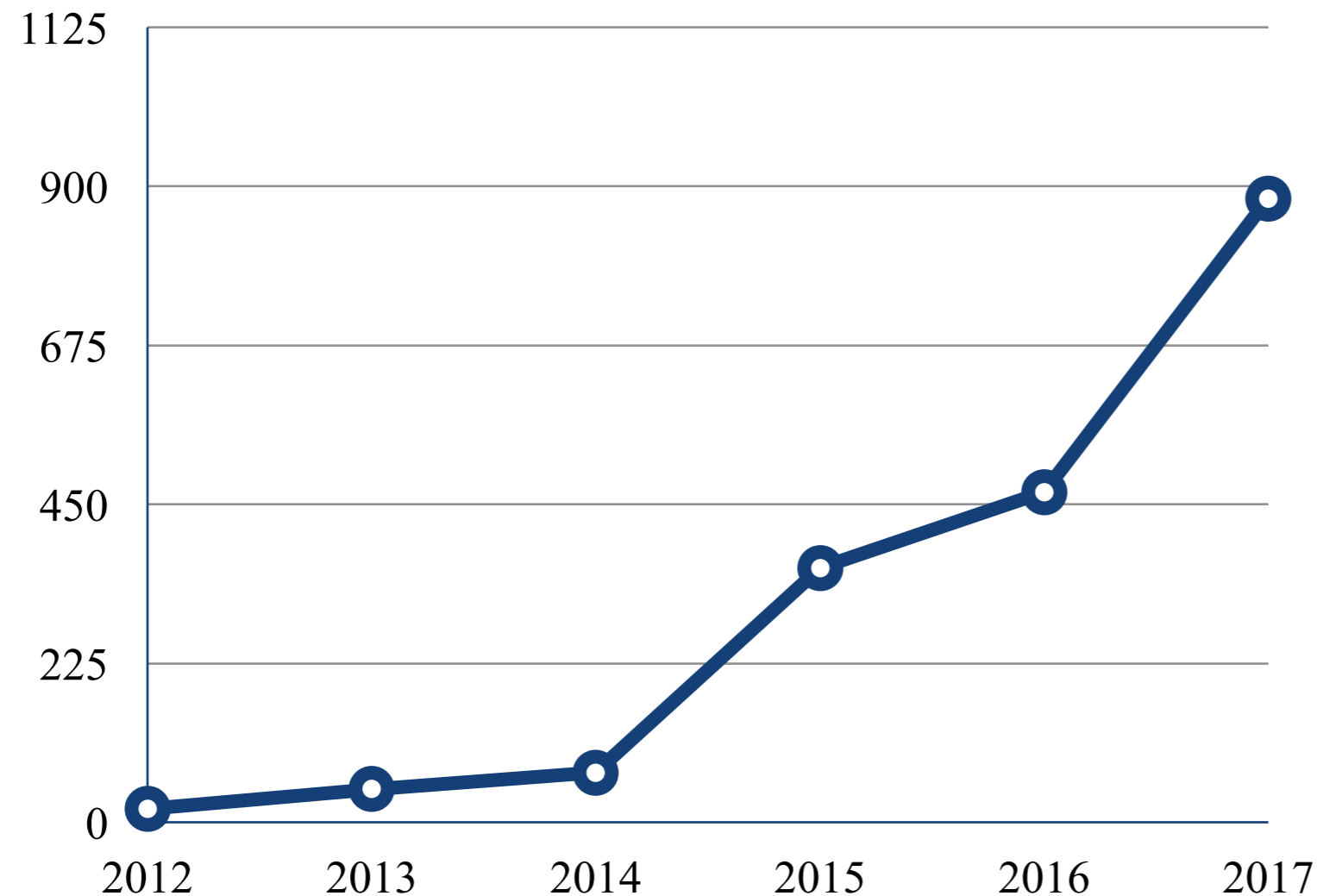

Corresponding authors of 129 articles published in 2017 come from **26 countries and regions** with 20% of them from USA.

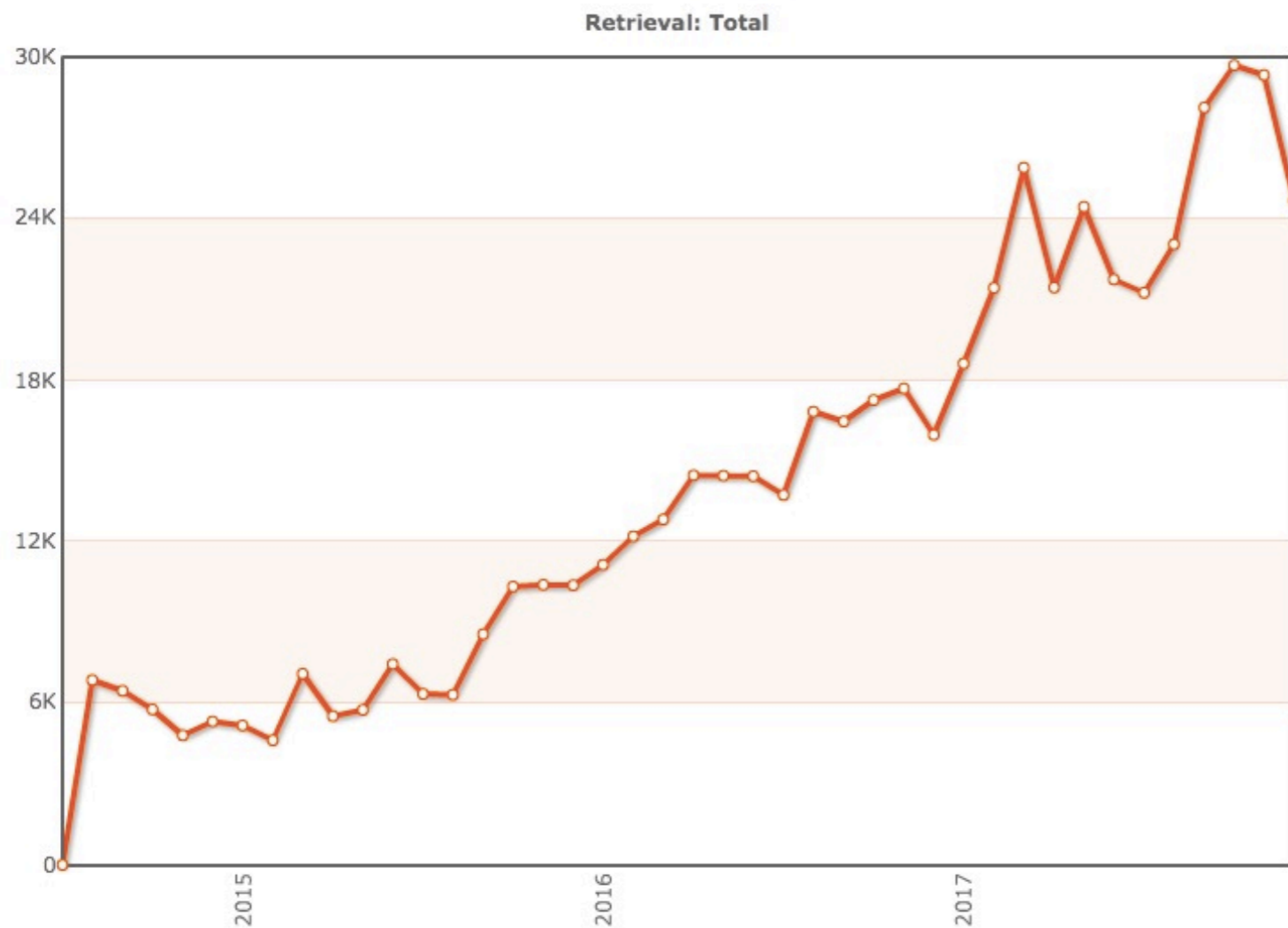
## 8. Citations of GS (results by year)

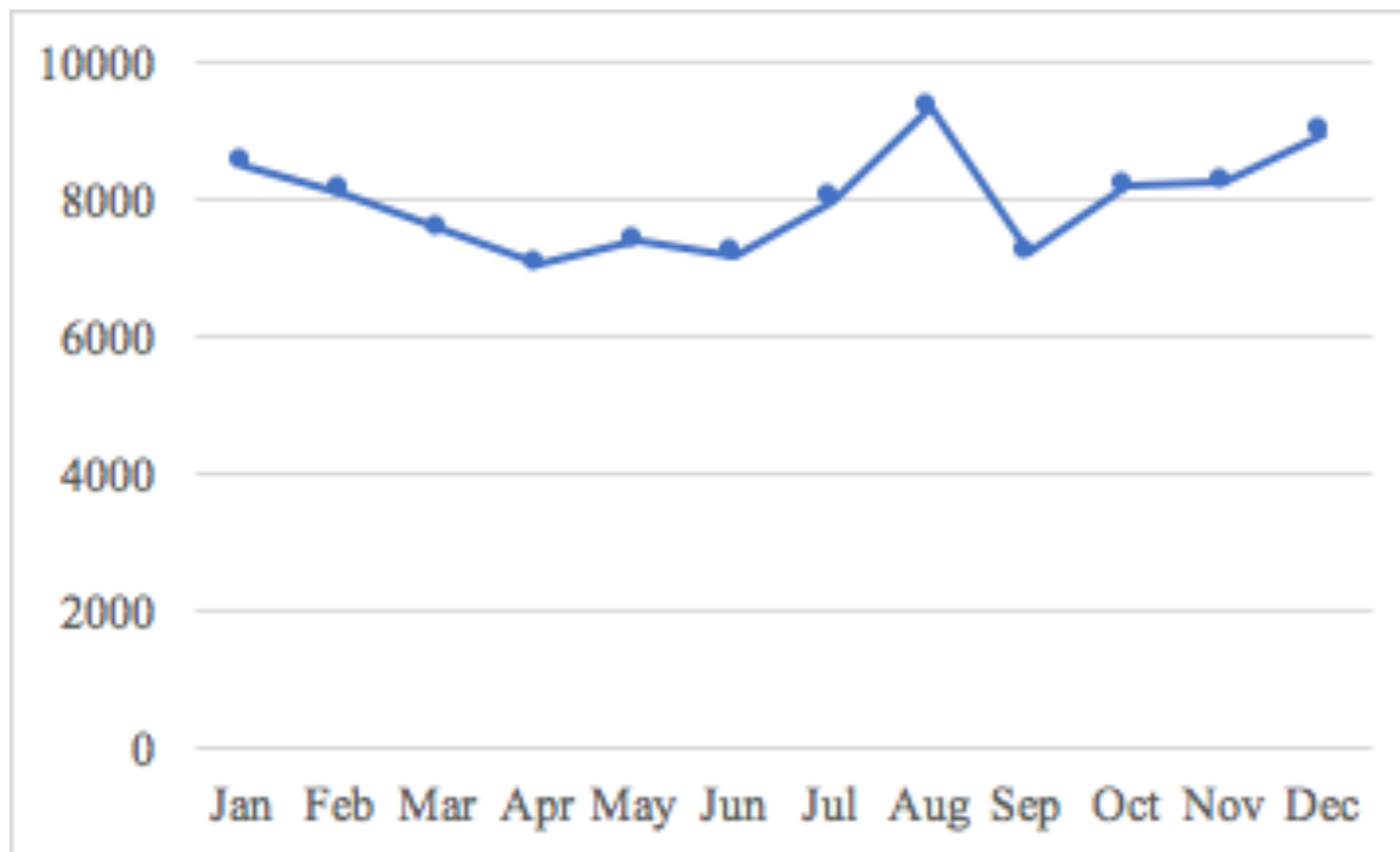
## 9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2017

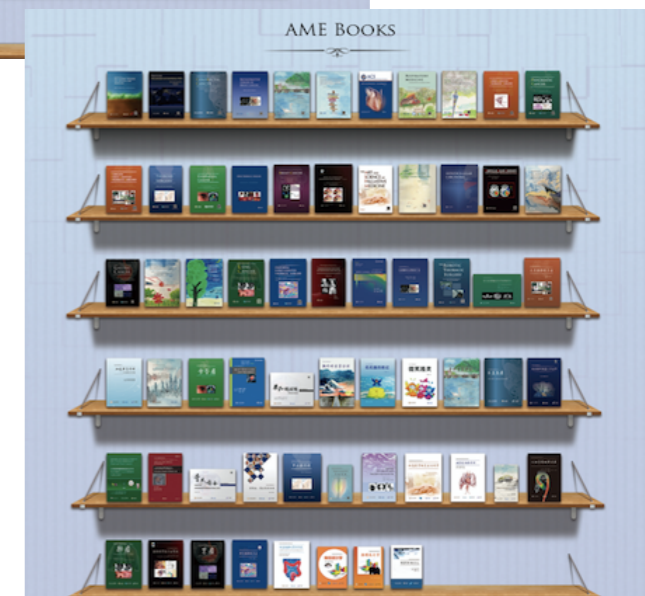

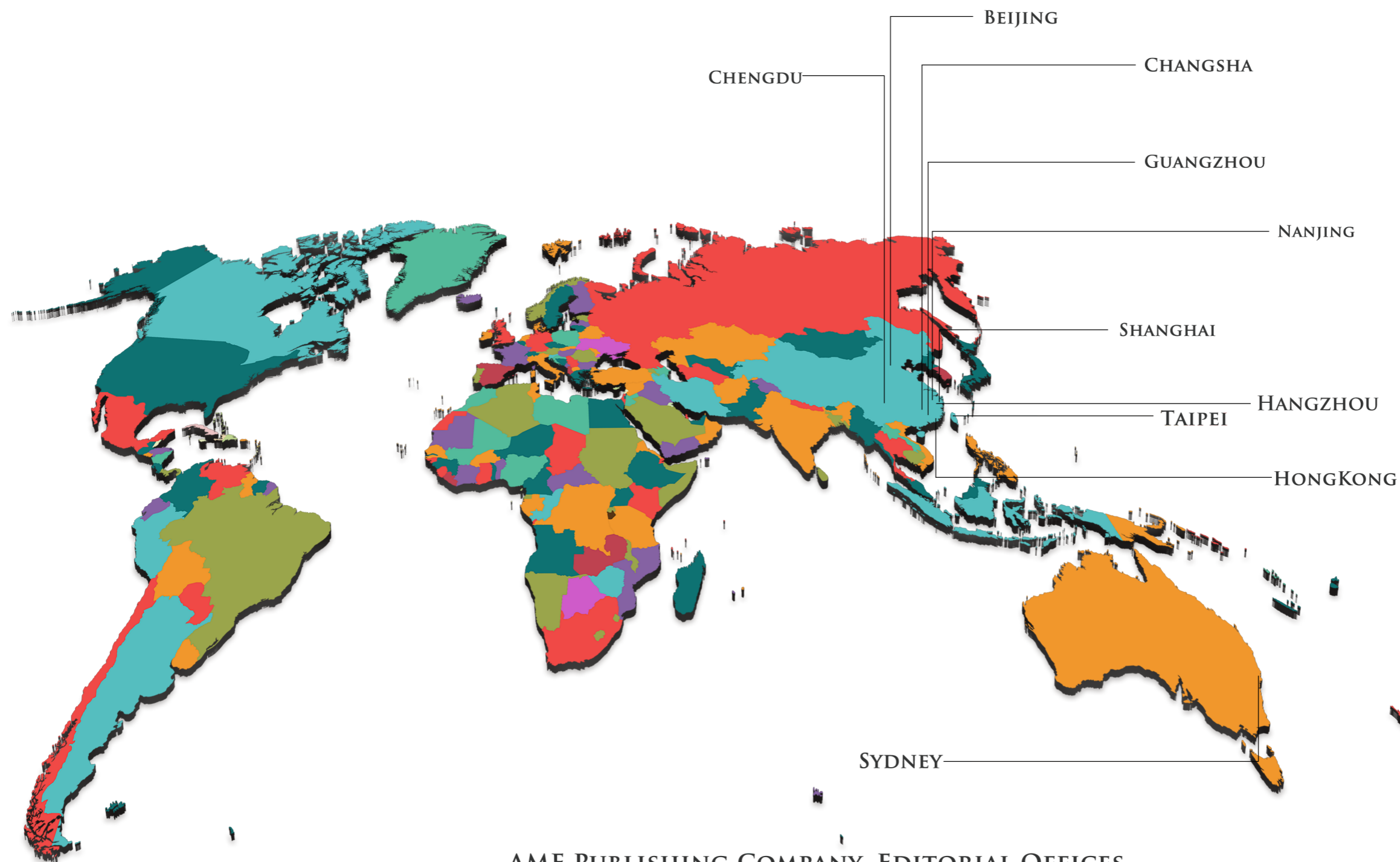
